- When you arrive come with a passport or visa
- The vaccine is free
- You will not be checked by the Immigration Authorities
- It is not available to people that are sick or recovering from COVID–19
- If you are in quarantine stay home and do not come to the vaccination center

Information on vaccination eligibility

Who is eligible for a vaccination at this site?

- Asylum seekers with a 5(A)2 visa
- B/1 work visa holders
- Migrant workers who entered the country prior to March 2020

Who is NOT eligible for a vaccination at this site?

- International students and participants in “Taglit” and “Masa” programs
- “Returning Residents” (“Toshav Hozer”) without Israeli health insurance
- Non–Israelis who came to take care of their family members and stayed in Israel
- Tourists who came for medical treatment and stayed in Israel
- Israelis who live abroad and do not have Israeli social benefits
- Tourists who arrived after March 2020 and did not leave the country
- Diplomats
- Clergy
